

# City takes honours in Golden Key award

IN RECOGNITION of its policies and practices in providing access to government information, the City of Cape Town has for the second year running taken the honours as the best municipality at the Golden Key Awards.

The awards stem from a collaboration between the Open Democracy Advice Centre and South African Human Rights Commission. The presentation ceremony took place on International Right to Know Day, September 28, in Joburg.

The awards acknowledge best practices by public institutions which promote openness, responsiveness and information-sharing through implementation of the Promotion of Access to Information Act.

A total of 82 institutions were sampled this year, of which 26 of which responded.

The City of Cape Town took the awards for Best Municipality for Openness and Responsiveness, and Best Deputy Information Officer.

City advocate Jill Fabing received an award in recognition of her commitment to promoting the right to access to information.
